One of the first steps that Governor Mills took when elected was to convene a PFAS Task Force to examine the scope of PFAS contamination across the state and provide recommendations to protect the health and environment of all Mainers. She signed into law several bills to protect access to clean drinking water and to reduce exposure to toxic PFAS. She also advocated for \$60 million dollars in the state budget to help farmers and well owners impacted by PFAS contamination. The funding will provide those impacted by PFAS contamination with resources such as income replacement, farm buybacks, and medical monitoring.

"Under the leadership of Governor Mills, Maine has been a national leader in managing the PFAS crisis, putting us far ahead of other states," Woodbury said. "We at Defend Our Health Action are proud to endorse her in the race for Governor and look forward to the work ahead."
